HISTORIOGRAPHY OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF RESEARCH WORK IN AGROSOIL OF UKRAINE (THE 30-TH OF THE XX-TH CENTURY)

Summary

In the article the author analyzes the literature and sources about the development of experimental work in Ukrainian agricultural soil science in the 1930s and identifies areas requiring further research.

In the process of analyzing industry literature of the Soviet period, it was revealed that the development of experimental agricultural soil work in the early 1930s was largely linked with professor G. G. Makhov. It was characterized by the appearance of his fundamental monograph "Ukrainian Soil," which summarized all that was done in the study of Ukrainian soil, as well as several articles dedicated to the history of experimental work in agricultural soil science. This was also mentioned in the research of O.N. Sokolovskyi, D. G. Vilenskyi, O. T. Kalachykov and a number of other scientists.

Since the 1950s, a brief inquiry into the history of native soil science was made by the famous scientists O. N. Sokolovskyi, P. A. Vlasiuk, and G. S. Grin, and in 1994 they were summarized by E. M. Grinchenko. Since Ukraine became independent, especially in the late 1990s, more attention has been paid to the history of agricultural science and its separate branches. The history of soil science development and the evaluation of the research of scientists who have played an

important role in its development are highlighted in the writings of V.I. Kanivets, D. I. Kovalyshyn, V. F. Saiko, E. G. Dehodiuk, G. A. Mazur, D. G. Tykhonenko, V. I. Onopriienko and others.
